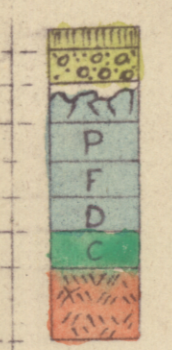


BAUXITE DEPOSITS AT OUSE

- Filling at shaft collars
  - Surface soil clay gravel, boulders etc.
  - Bauxite boulders
  - Pisolithic bauxite
  - Friable bauxite, usually with iron concretions
  - Dense, fine grained bauxite, usually rich in iron
  - Mixed seams of clay and bauxite
  - Residual clays and other siliceous decomposition products
