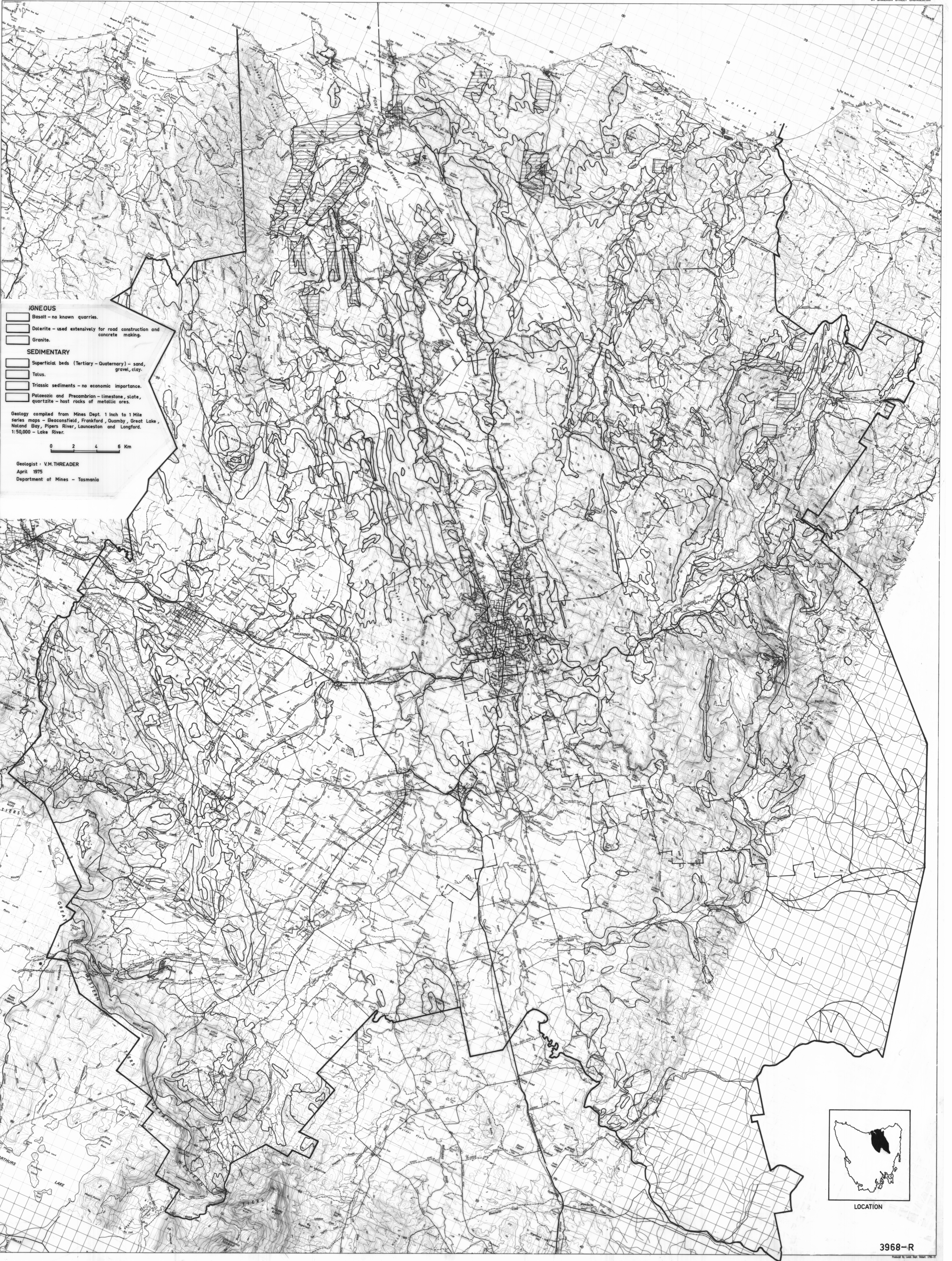


# GEOLOGY TAMAR REGION

**IGNEOUS**

- Basalt - no known quarries.
- Dolerite - used extensively for road construction and concrete making.
- Granite.

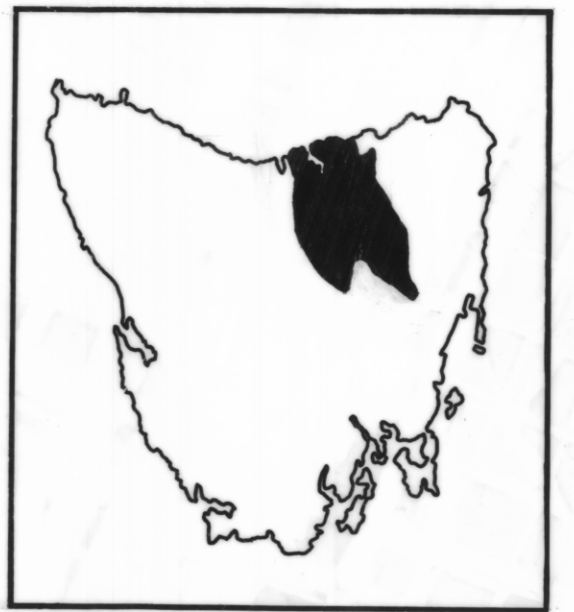
**SEDIMENTARY**

- Superficial beds (Tertiary - Quaternary) - sand, gravel, clay.
- Talus.
- Triassic sediments - no economic importance.
- Palaeozoic and Precambrian - limestone, slate, quartzite - host rocks of metallic ores.
