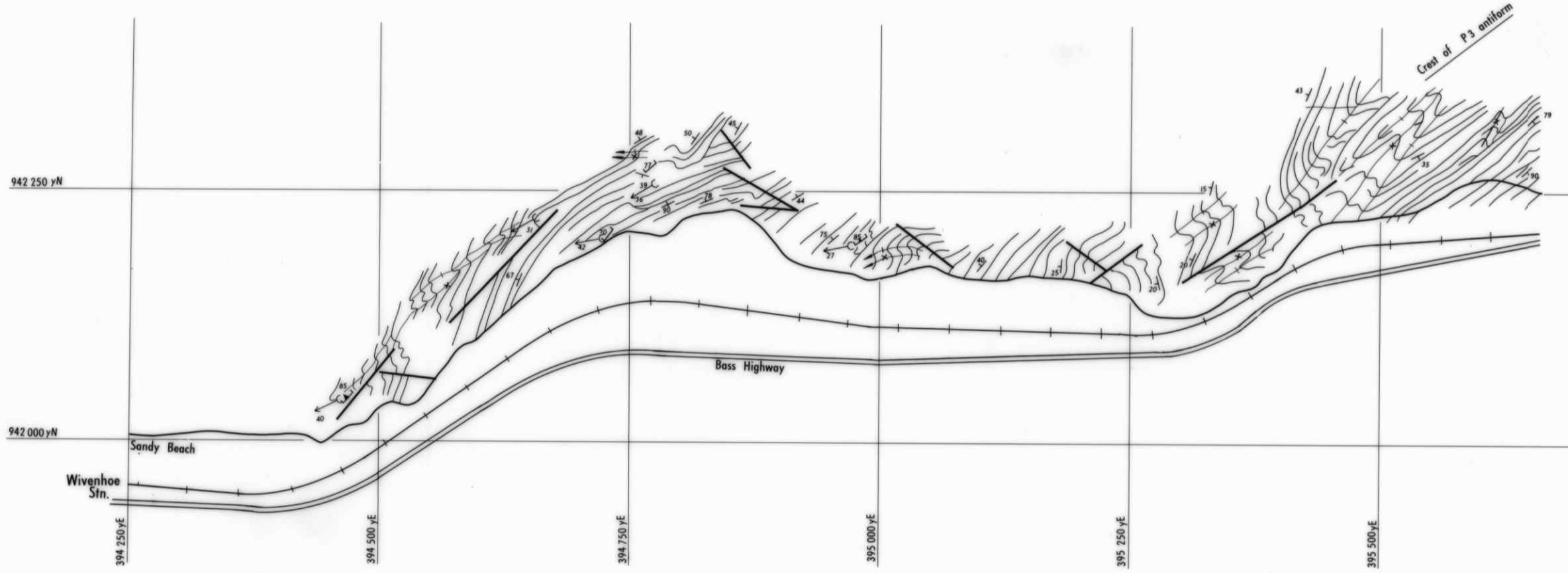
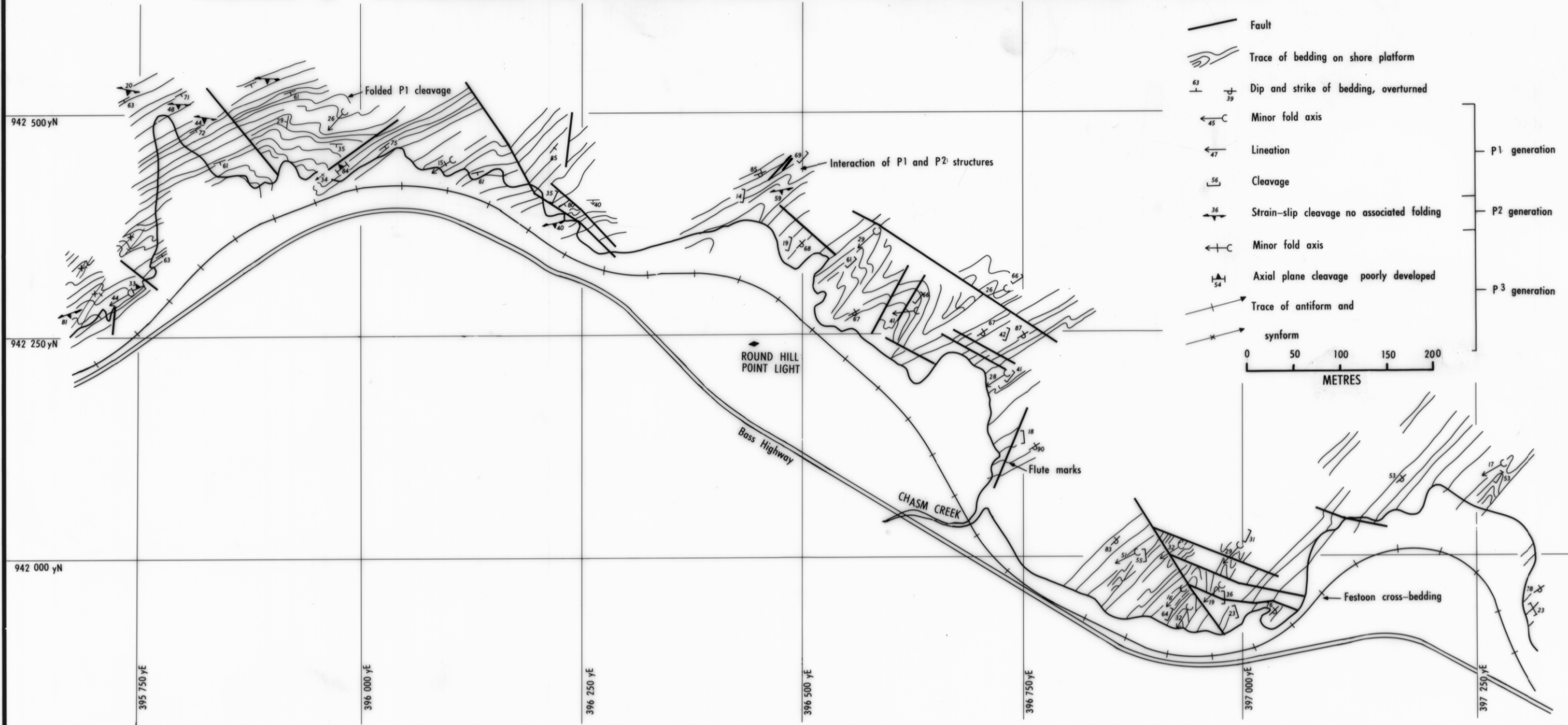

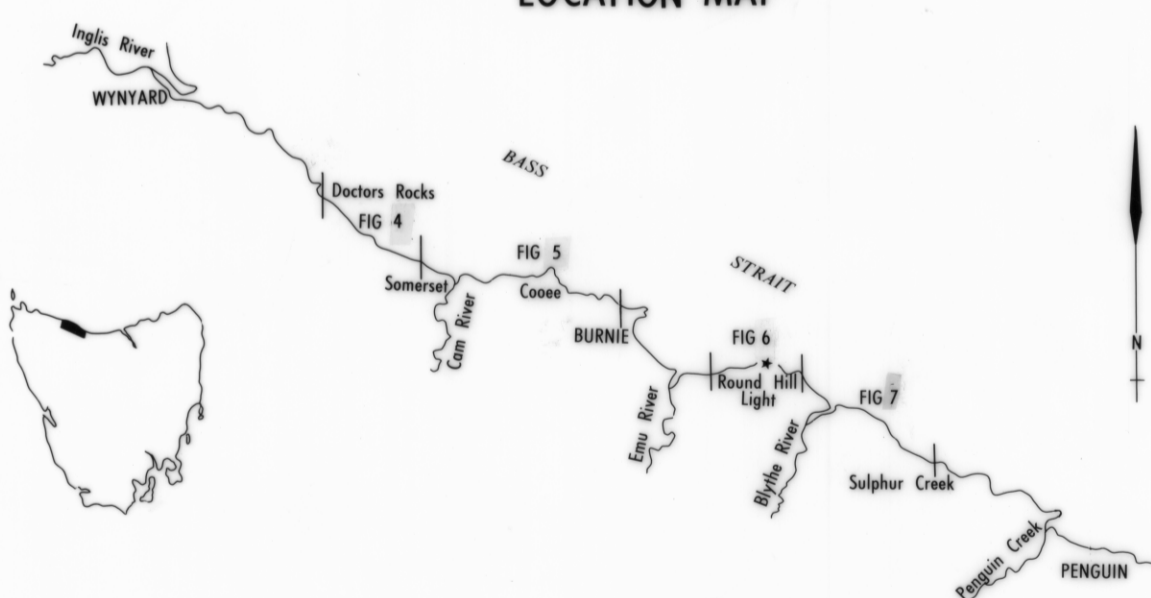
FIGURE 6 WIVENHOE TO CHASM CREEK WITH COMPREHENSIVE LEGEND
