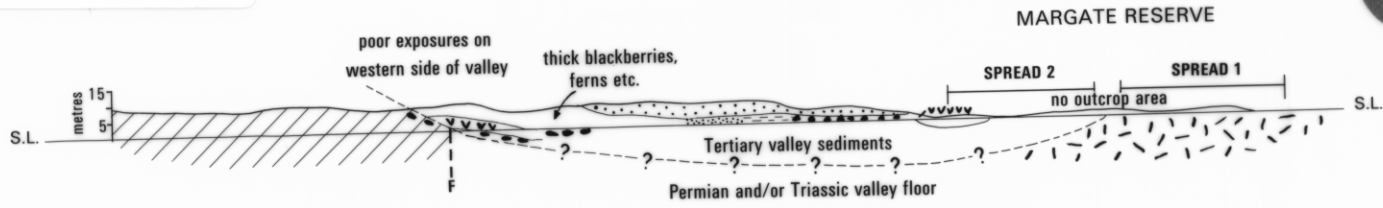
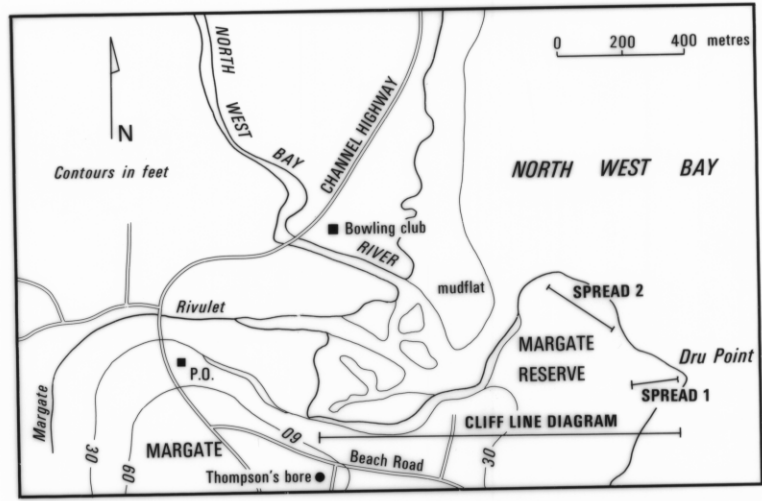

- QUATERNARY
 - River terrace gravels.
 - Volcanic agglomerate of red clay and 'rotten' basalt boulders. Valley fill sediments.
 - Basalt - often weathered to clay.
- TERTIARY
 - Clay.
 - Sand.
 - Silcrete boulders.
- JURASSIC
 - Dolerite.
- PERMIAN
 - Bedded fossiliferous Malbina Formation siltstone and mudstone with minor sandstone beds.
