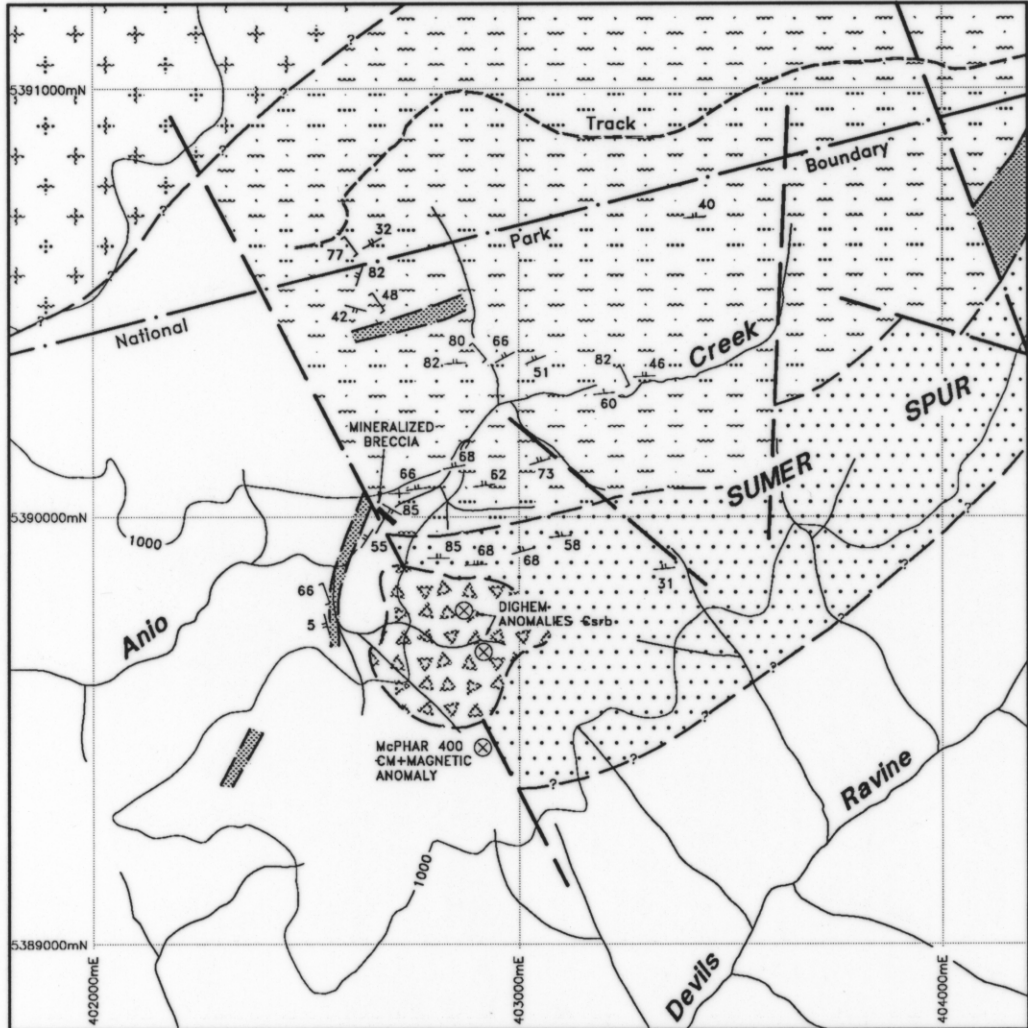


ANIO CREEK PROSPECT, LOCATION OF ANOMALY 13

- Quaternary**
 - Talus, scree, slope deposits.
- Cambrian**
 - Quartz-feldspar porphyry.
 - Quartz-feldspar-biotite-hornblende porphyry. Bonds Range porphyry.
 - Interbedded pale grey vitric tuff, crystal-vitric tuff, tuffaceous sandstone, dark grey cherty siltstone, minor mass-flow tuff. Back Peak Beds
 - Interbedded quartzite, sandstone, granule conglomerate and minor siliciclastic breccia. Correlate of Sticht Range Beds.
- Precambrian**
 - Phyllite and micaceous schist with subordinate quartzite.
- Bedding, facing unknown, known, vertical.
- Strike and dip of cleavage.
