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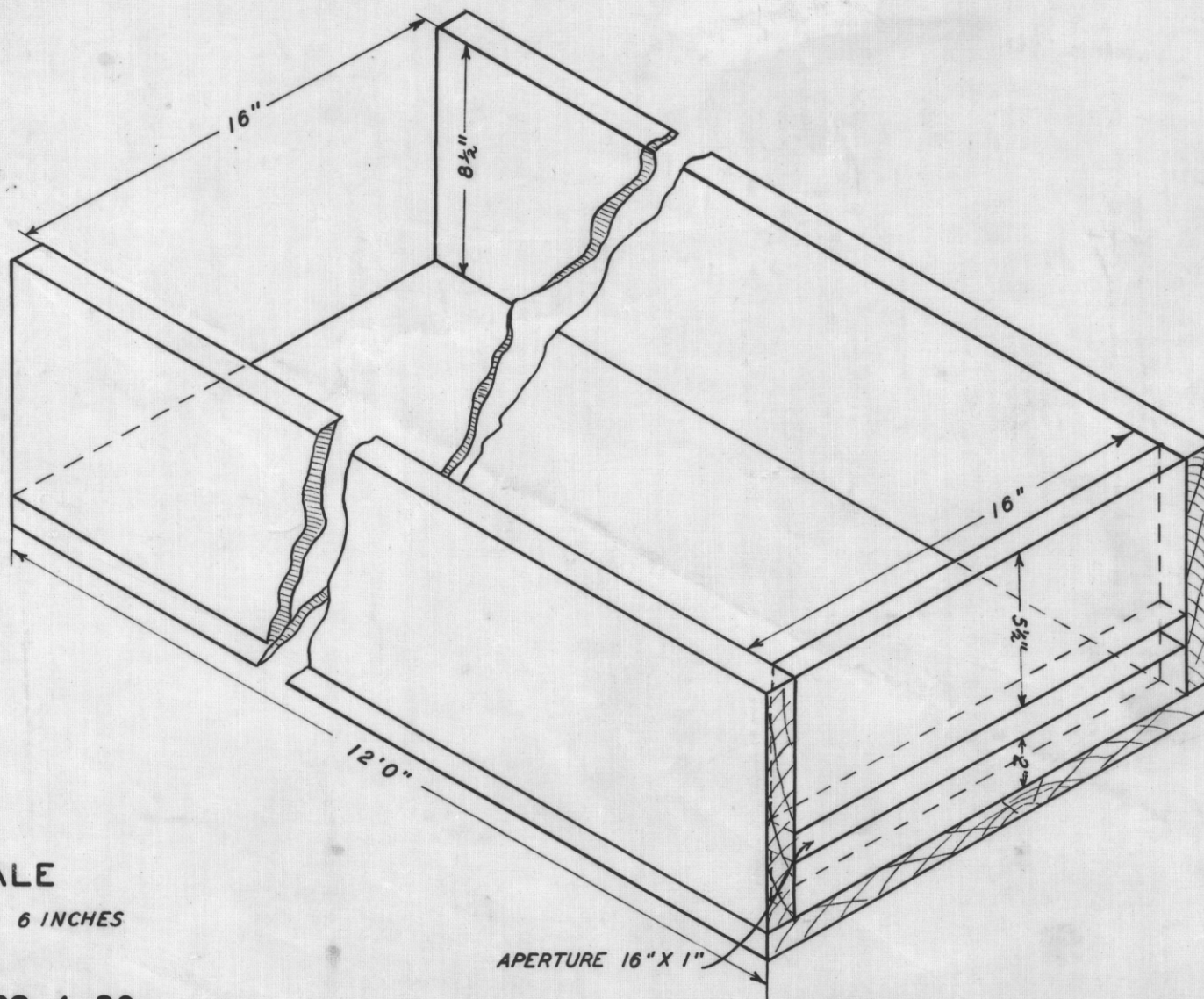

MEASUREMENT OF WATER

GAUGE BOX FOR ONE SLUICEHEAD



NOTE. BOX MUST BE SET TRULY HORIZONTAL AND MUST NOT OVERFLOW.
THE APERTURE OPEN THE FULL WIDTH OF THE BOX EXTENDS FROM 2 INCHES ABOVE THE FLOOR THEREOF FOR SUCH DISTANCE ACCORDING TO THE NUMBER OF SLUICEHEADS TO BE MEASURED THEREBY, AS IS INDICATED IN THE FOLLOWING TABLE NAMELY:
