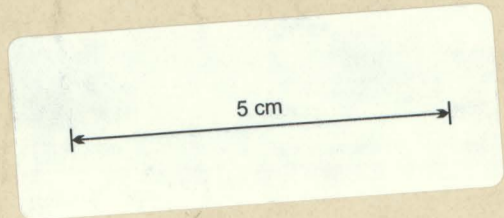
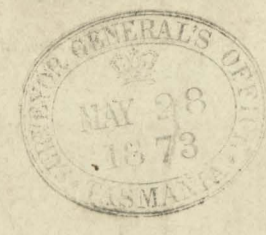


PLAN OF MINERAL SECTIONS

 with 36 700 ac Smith's side of 200000 20 April 1875 by lease No 92. 1000
 issued in a name of Livingston Prop. James Smith. No 92. 1000
 date 1st Aug 1875. afterwards amalgamated with No 93 80ac
 this lease 629 2000 acres transferred to Mrs Bischoff T.M. & Co
 transferred to Mrs Bischoff T.M. & Co by 23/11/75 assigned by lease

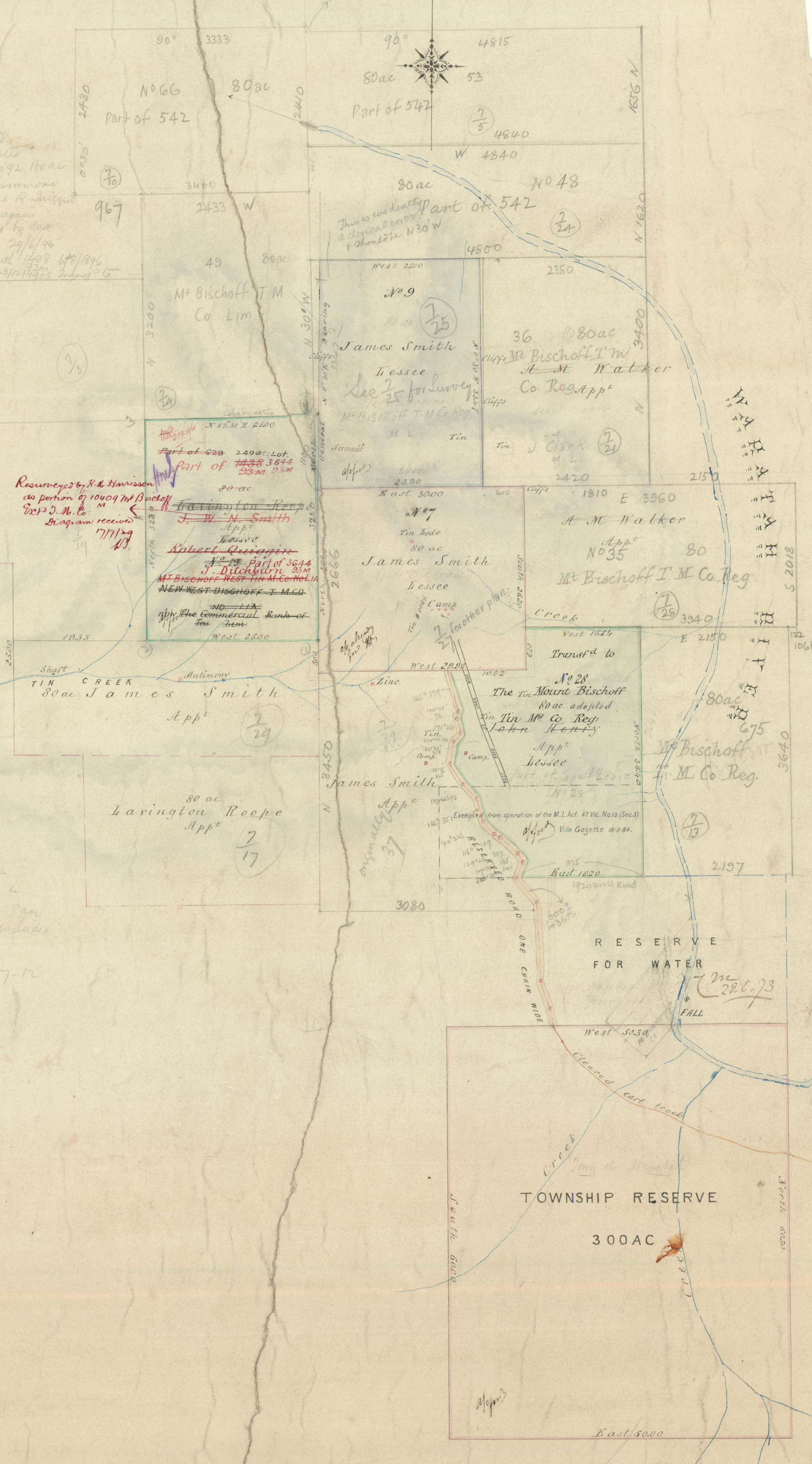
