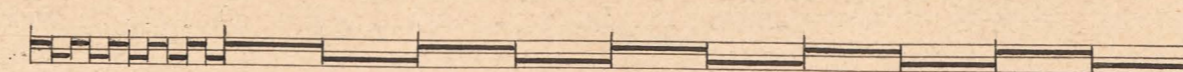


DIAGRAM FROM ACTUAL SURVEY

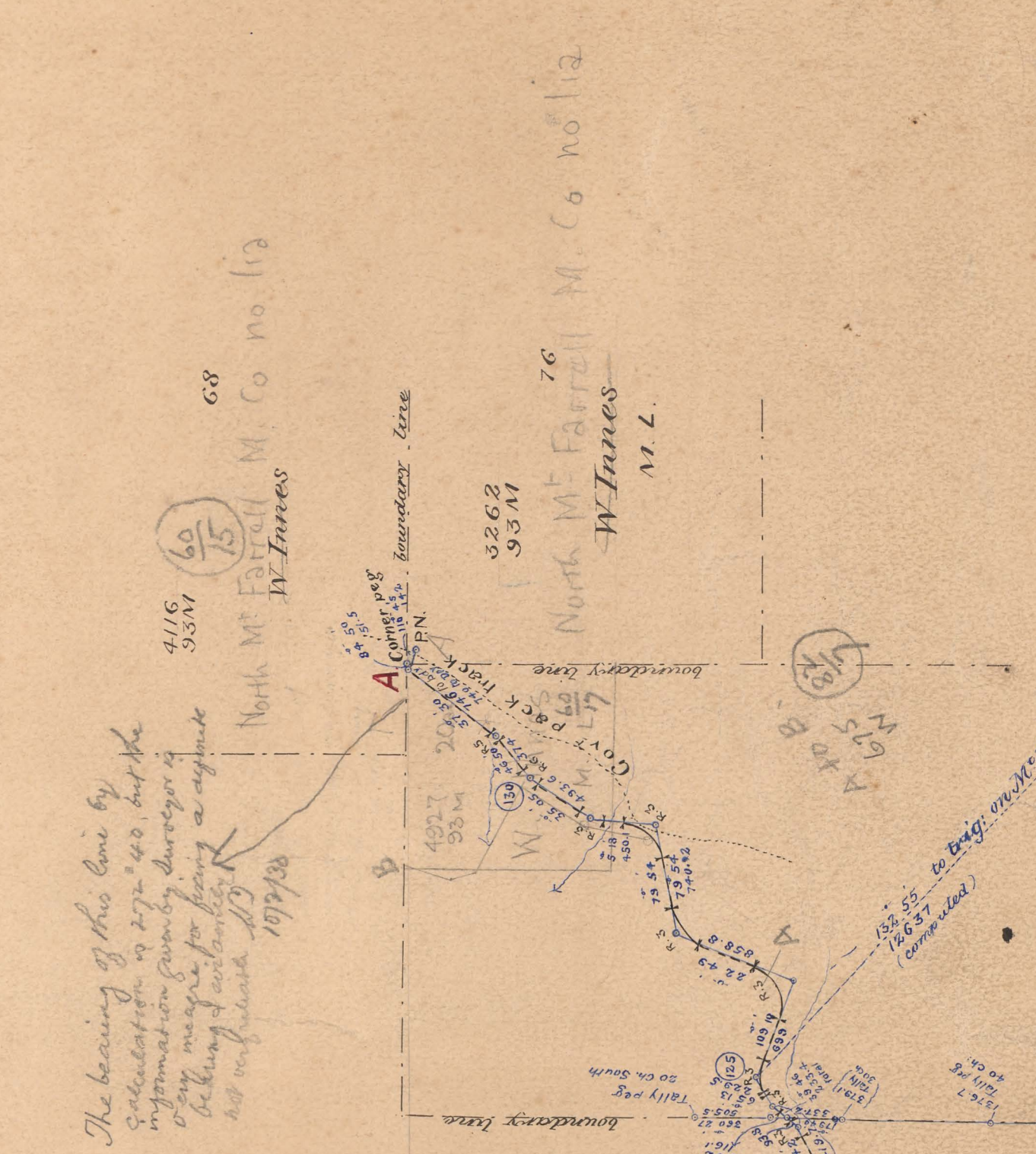
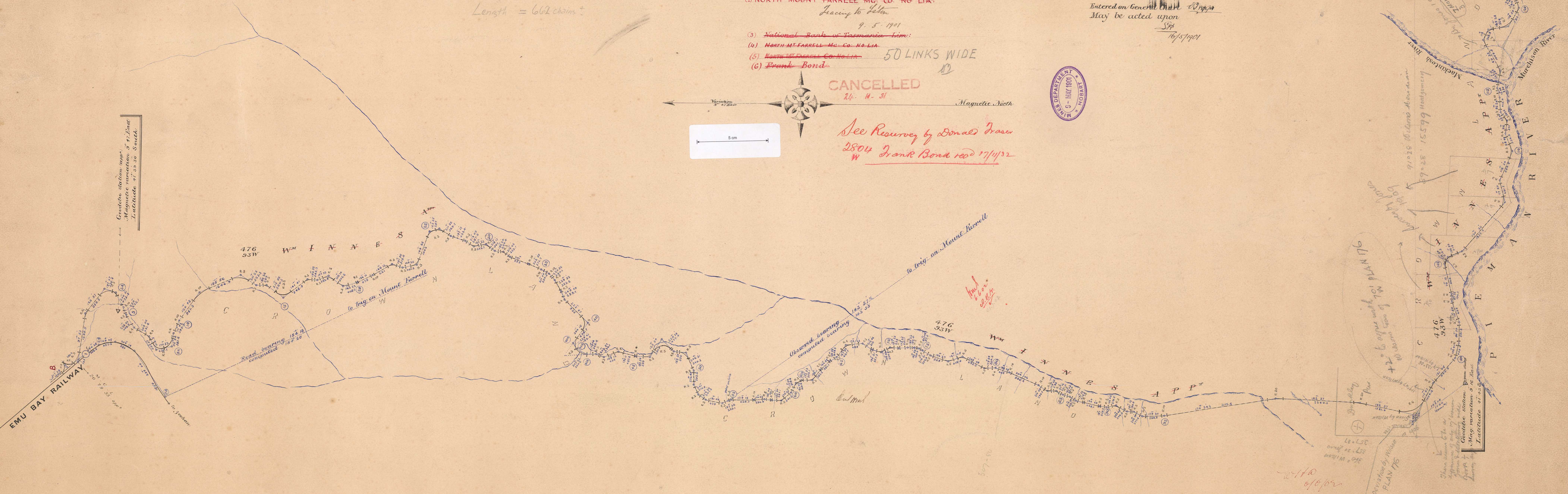

In County Russell the marked line passes through Crown land from the same line (Railway) to the Mackintosh River - continuing through County Lincoln past through Brown land to a point some miles past the point through Brown land to a point some miles past the point from the measurement where it enters a surveyed block apparently a farm reserve, and passes through the line between boundary of Block 4116. 93W & the name of W. James - when the survey ends.

The marked line continues in no public road or work unmarked with masonry.

As shown in field notes, a residence area in the name of Mr. Alexander is held in vicinity of the Mackintosh River. The area is within one chain of the line. The line is shown as shown in plan at the bottom of the map - it shows no other area.
