I have the honor to forward report upon
Water Right No $\frac{237}{93W}$ Edward Gaunt Applicant
from Egans Ct. to section No $\frac{1191}{83M}$ standing in
the name of the Rex Hill S. M. Co. Limited

1st: The water right in question passes through
Crown and lease lands. It starts from
proposed Dam site on Egans Ct. and after
receiving the water from the Buffalo Ct.
under Water Right $\frac{238}{93W}$ thence to the Rex Hill
S. Mining Section No $\frac{1191}{87M}$ picking up the waters
of Sunlight Ct. (see my report on Water Right No $\frac{2029}{77H}$)
it then passes through section $\frac{2026}{87M}$ then through
part of Sections $\frac{4238}{93M}$ $\frac{4234}{93M}$ $\frac{4237}{93M}$ of 80 acres
each standing in the name of J. C. Mackinnon
also through section of 52 acres in the name of
C. N. Foster No $\frac{3460}{93M}$ and Section $\frac{3677}{93M}$ standing
in the name of A. J. Niketich to section $\frac{1191}{83M}$ of
the Rex Hill S. M. Co.

2nd The Water right in question crosses the
Bentons Road near Buffalo Ct. the nature
of the country admits of the race
being carried under the Road with a
covering of not less than 18 inches it does
not interfere with any other Water Right or
work connected with Mining

(3) I do not see any other matter connected
with the Water Right that should be brought
under the notice of the Department

Survey of Race was commenced 25th Nov^r 1899

The length of the Race is 3 miles 48 chains
