

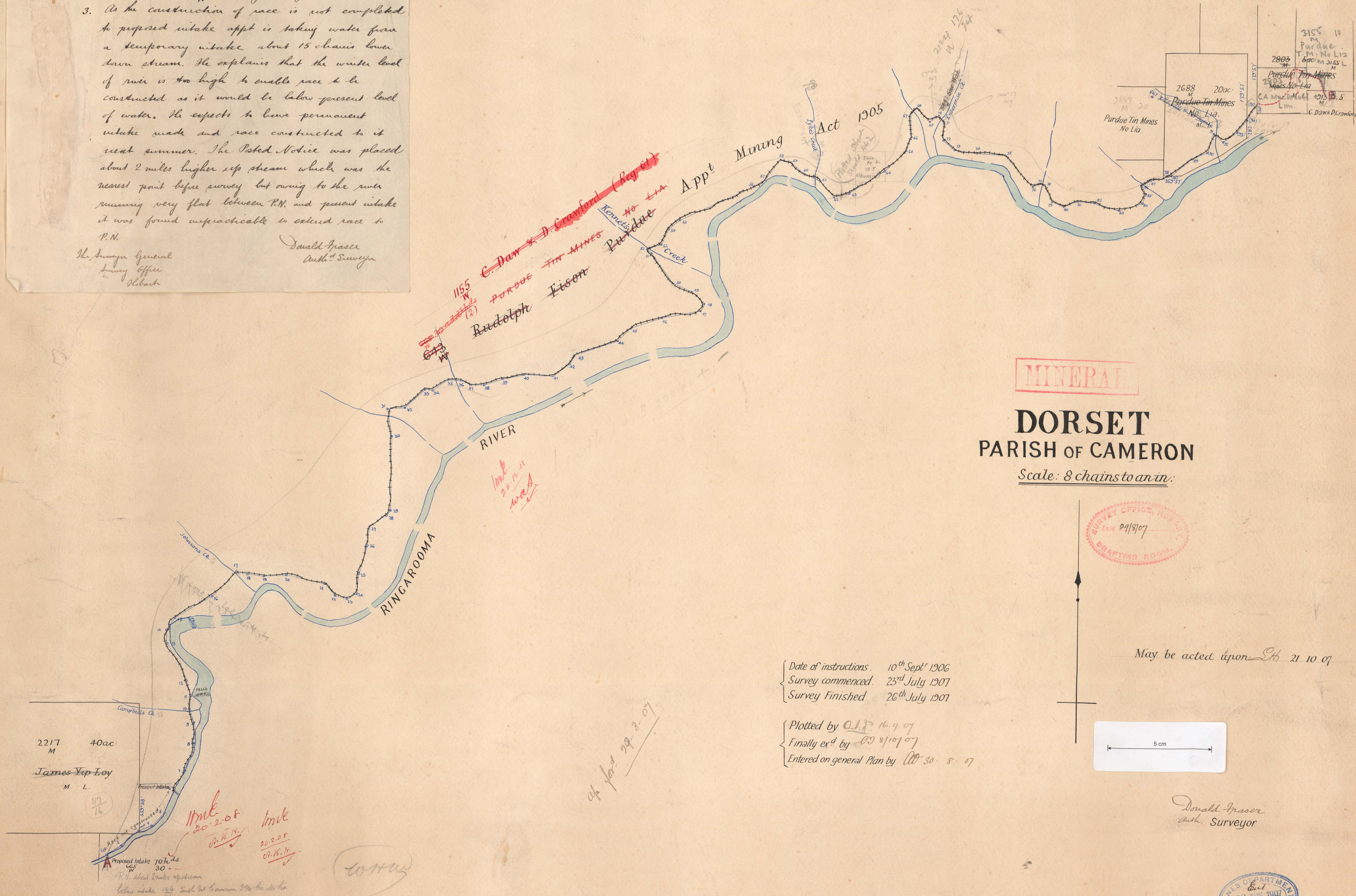
Dorby, 28<sup>th</sup> August 1907

Report on 623 - Rudolph Fison Purdue Appt.  
for 70 sluice-heads from Ringarooma  
River under "The Mining Act, 1905".

1. Part passes over 2217 - 40 ac. James Yip Loy M.L.
2. No part passes over any public road.  
Part passes over 544 Sue Wah  
Part passes over 677 R. J. Lyall + J. M. Bwinie
3. As the construction of race is not completed to proposed intake appt is taking water from a temporary intake about 15 chains lower down stream. He explains that the winter level of river is too high to enable race to be constructed as it would be below present level of water. He expects to have permanent intake made and race constructed to its next summer. The Pated Notice was placed about 2 miles higher up stream which was the nearest point before survey but owing to the river running very flat between P.N. and present intake it was found impracticable to extend race to P.N.

PARISH OF CAMERON**

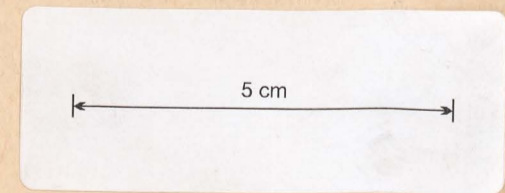
