

SURVEY OF APPLICATION

Please arrange for a Survey to be made and a Plan furnished of the land referred to in the Application under the Mining Act 1929, and Regulations, the Particulars of which are hereunder given. A report is to be furnished by the Surveyor on the following matters:—

- (a) Whether the Regulations under which the Application was made have been complied with in respect of marking off, and the requisite Notice posted.
- (b) Whether the whole or any part of the land is occupied by any person other than the Applicant and, if so, by whom, and under what alleged authority. If held as a Miner's Right Claim or Prospecting Claim, approximate position of such Claim to be shown on the plan, and date of marking off to be stated in the report.
- (c) Whether any Water Right or other work connected with mining exists on the land, or any public road or public reserve.
- (d) Any matter connected with the land which may be considered of sufficient importance to be brought under the notice of the Department.

It will be necessary to show upon the Plan the position of the Posted Notice, and the number of the application, also any roads or tracks which the Surveyor recommends should be reserved, and to what width and depth.

Timely notice must be given to the applicant of the intention of the Surveyor to proceed with the Survey.
