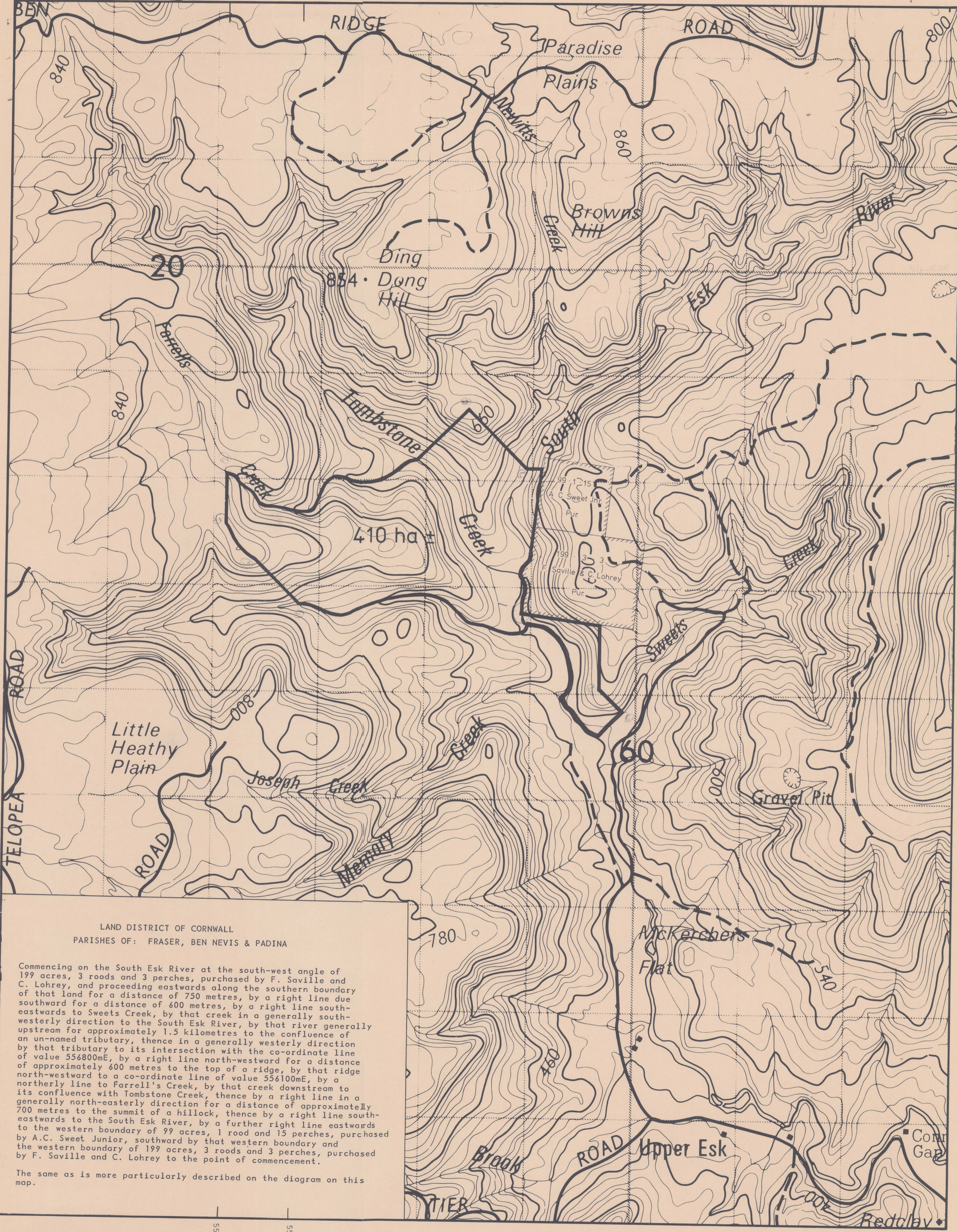
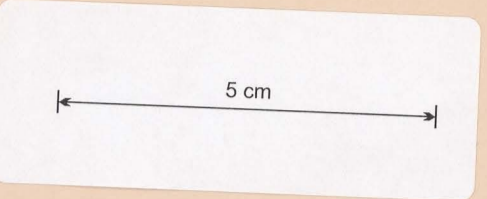


TOMBSTONE CREEK FOREST RESERVE

LAND DISTRICT OF CORNWALL
PARISHES OF: FRASER, BEN NEVIS & PADINA

Commencing on the South Esk River at the south-west angle of 199 acres, 3 roods and 3 perches, purchased by F. Saville and C. Lohrey, and proceeding eastwards along the southern boundary of that land for a distance of 750 metres, by a right line due southward for a distance of 600 metres, by a right line south-eastwards to Sweets Creek, by that creek in a generally south-westerly direction to the South Esk River, by that river generally upstream for approximately 1.5 kilometres to the confluence of an un-named tributary, thence in a generally westerly direction by that tributary to its intersection with the co-ordinate line of value 556800mE, by a right line north-westward for a distance of approximately 600 metres to the top of a ridge, by that ridge north-westward to a co-ordinate line of value 556100mE, by a northerly line to Forrell's Creek, by that creek downstream to its confluence with Tombstone Creek, thence by a right line in a generally north-easterly direction for a distance of approximately 700 metres to the summit of a hillock, thence by a right line south-eastwards to the South Esk River, by a further right line eastwards to the western boundary of 99 acres, 1 rood and 15 perches, purchased by A.C. Sweet Junior, southward by that western boundary and the western boundary of 199 acres, 3 roods and 3 perches, purchased by F. Saville and C. Lohrey to the point of commencement.
