CROWN LANDS ACT, 1976

ORDER NO. 51 OF 1980

In pursuance and exercise of the powers conferred on me by Section 8 of the Crown Lands Act, 1976, I ANDREW BARNARD KEITH LOHREY being and as the Minister for the time being administering that Act, hereby make the following order:

Crown Lands (Public Recreation and Amusement and Land Conservation)

Order 1980

1. Short title.

This order may be cited as the Crown Lands (Public Recreation and Amusement and Land Conservation) Order 1980.

2. For the purposes of Section 8 of the Crown Lands Act, the land

described in the Schedule hereto is reserved to the Crown for Public Recreation and Amusement and Land Conservation purposes to be known as the Snug Falls State Recreation Area.

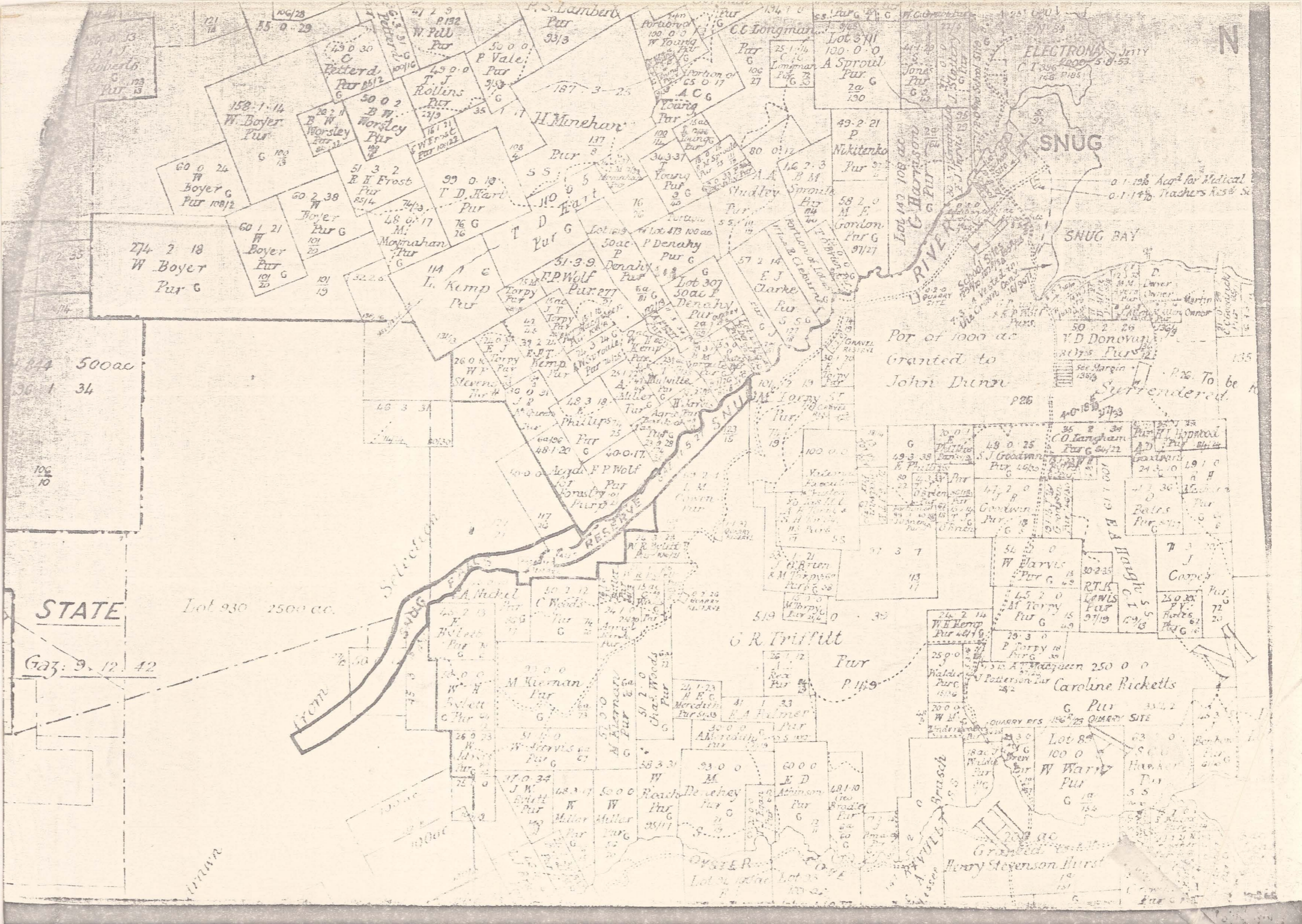

SCHEDULE

Land District of Buckingham
Parishes of Kingborough and Coningham
Snug Falls State Recreation Area
81 Hectares or Thereabouts

All that area of land situate in the Land District of Buckingham Parishes of Kingborough and Coningham containing 81 hectares or thereabouts commencing at the source of the Snug River and bounded by a northerly line for a distance of 80.44 metres thence in a general easterly and north-easterly direction parallel to and distant 80.44 metres from the centre of the Snug River aforesaid to the south-west boundary of 48 acres 1 rood 20 perches (19.58ha) acquired for forestry purposes thence by a portion of that boundary and by the south east boundary of that land by the south east boundary of 40 acres 0 roods 17 perches (16.23ha) purchased by F.P. Wolf thence by a south easterly line to the Snug River aforesaid thence by the north western bank of that river to a point opposite the north west angle of 104 acres 2 roods 19 perches (42.34ha) purchased by Michael Torpy the Elder thence by a southerly line crossing the Snug River by a portion of the west boundary of the last mentioned land thence by the north west boundary of 69 acres 2 roods 4 perches (20.14ha) purchased by L.M. Cowen and by the west boundary of that land thence by portion of the north boundary of 24 acres 3 roods 28 perches (10.09ha) purchased by W.R. Bylett and by the west boundary of that land thence by portion of the north boundary of 21 acres 1 rood 26 perches (8.66ha) purchased by W.R. Bylett and by a north boundary of 16 acres 1 rood 6 perches (6.59ha) purchased by J.V. Butler by portion of the west boundary of that land thence by the northern boundary of 50 acres 2 roods 12 perches (20.26ha) purchased by Charles Woods by portion of the west boundary of that land thence by a north boundary of 45 acres 0 roods 10 perches (18.24ha) purchased by A. Nickel by an east boundary and by the north boundary of that land thence by portion of the west boundary of 45 acres 2 roods 13 perches (18.45ha) purchased by Ellen Bylett to a point on that boundary 80.44 metres from the centre of the Snug River thence by a line in a general south westerly and westerly direction parallel to and distant 80.44 metres from the centre of the Snug River aforesaid to a point opposite the source thereof and thence by a northerly line for a distance of 80.44 metres to the point of commencement.
