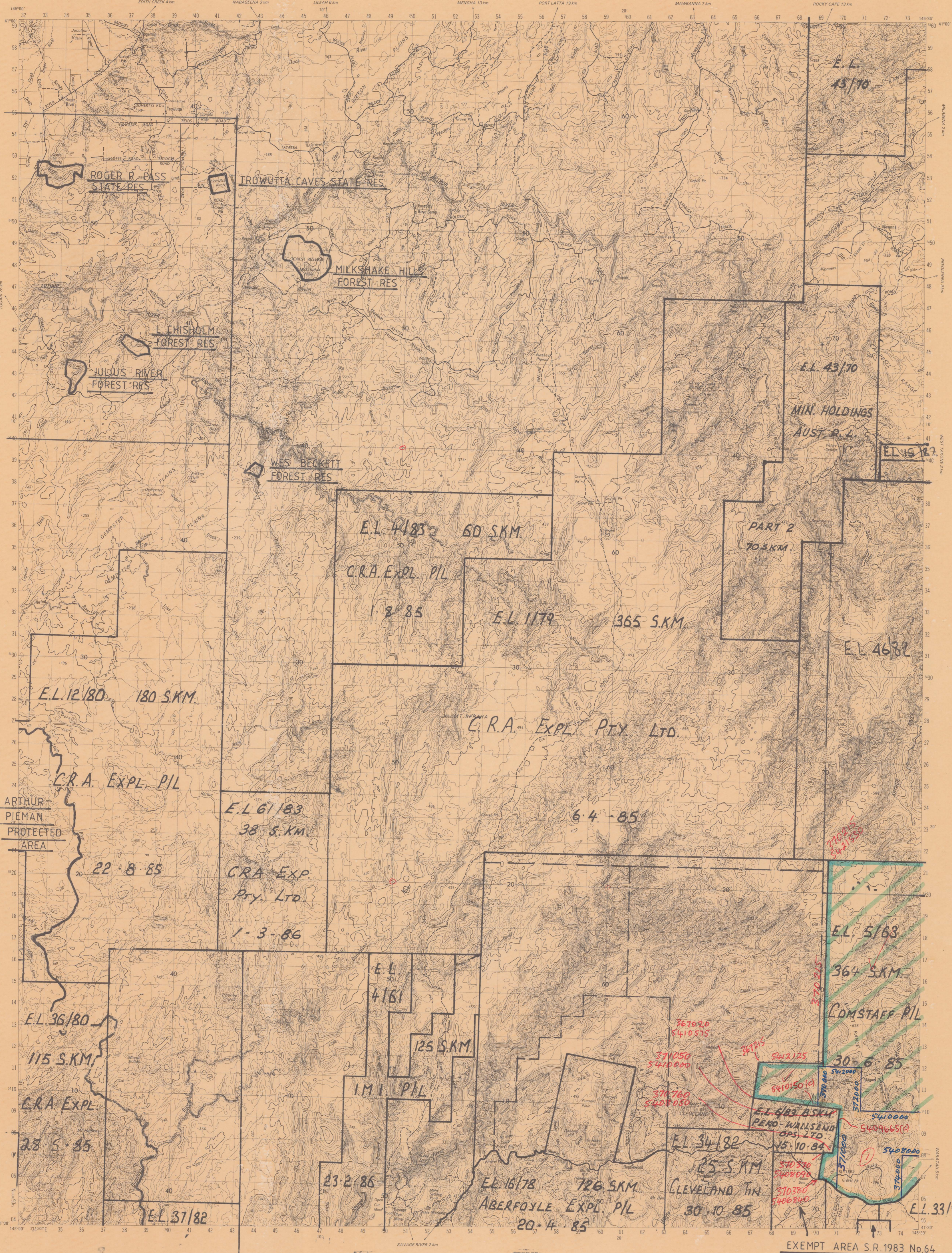

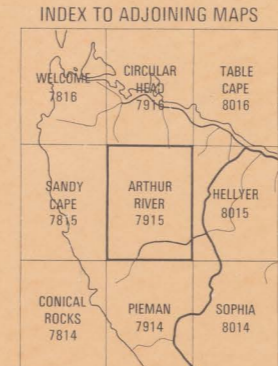
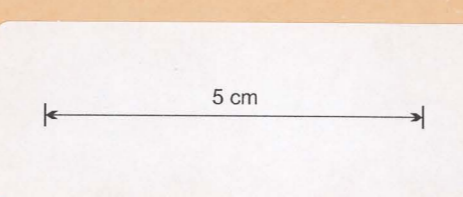

 SAMPLE POINT: 793.2 MT. BERTHA  
 1. Read letters identifying 100 000 metre square in which point lies.  
 2. Locate first VERTICAL grid line to LEFT of point and read LARGE figure identifying the line in either the top or bottom margin, or on the line itself.  
 3. Estimate metres from grid line to point.  
 4. Locate first HORIZONTAL grid line BELOW point and read LARGE figure identifying the line in either the left margin, or on the line itself.  
 5. Estimate metres from grid line to point.
