URANIUM PROSPECT

On Thursday, 30th May, I inspected the uranium prespect of Mr. Kellet, approximately one mile south of the Tasmanian United Uranium base, Rossarden.

Mr. Kellet's two sites are on the western side of Storeys Creek in granite, the first about 150' above creek level, the second about 250' above creek level. Both sites show the uranium mineral, carnotite.

In neither case is sufficient exposed to assess the worth of the prospects. A course of further work was suggested as a step in discovering their full extent.
