Monday 9th June.

Left Hobart 9 a.m. and arrived Launceston 12.15 p.m. Wound cable off spare drill stored in Commonwealth Works Department. Left for Burnie and arrived 6 p.m.

Tuesday 10th June.

Left 7.50 a.m. for Zeehan by rail motor. Took all details of the Paul Jet pump at the Mines Department residence. Called on Mr. Hodge to be informed he had posted stamp duty and filing fees (£2/10/-) on Mortgage
