Fook's lode, Waratah

It is recommended that an area of 320 acres surrounding "Fook's Lode" at Waratah be resumed by the Crown and reserved to the Crown for future mineral exploration. A description and plan of the area is attached.

The area comprises:

1. 80 acres — Fook's prospecting rights.
2. 74 acres — of 5AP/AM, Aberfoyle Tin NL.
3. 166 acres — of 4AP/AM, ES&A Nominees (Comstaff)

The 80 acres of N. Fooks would be of no interest to any organisation with the exception of Comstaff which holds 4AP/AM covering lode 'deeps' to the south.

Also attached is a plan of the present trenching etc. on Fook's lode with tentative initial proposed drill sites.

Further study will be necessary to formulate a final drilling programme, but an initial programme of three (3) 500 feet holes would indicate an extension of the ore body to a depth of about 200 feet below the outcrop.

Description of land

*Land District of Russell
Vicinity of Waratah
320 acres*

Commencing at the south east angle of the area being on Smith St, situate at the south east angle of 30.0.0 C. Kent Pur. and bounded on the east by 42 chains northerly along the eastern boundary of that land and along Crown Land on the north by 76 chains westerly to the Waratah River thence by that river in a general southerly direction to Smith St, aforesaid and on the south by 72 chains easterly along that Street to the point of commencement
