## **Examination of a river bed sample from Risdon**

A fine reddish-brown material dredged from the river bottom at Risdon Wharf has been examined and found to be made up of occasional grains of quartz and other minerals, pieces of slag and a magnetic brown powder.

The powder consists of magnetic iron oxides and limonite with traces of zinc and copper.
