This line of bores commences about 45 chains north west of Calloway Section Claim (See 4121/93) and proceeds instead on a bearing of 36° to the vicinity of Stinking Springs, a distance of about 90 chains. At 55 chains the Old 56 feet shaft is passed, at 62 chains the Mount Cameron Water Race is crossed. It is not anticipated that any good ^{tin} will be obtained until the vicinity of the deep shaft is reached.
