SUBJECT: Rehabilitation of Sterling Valley and Farrell Drill Pad Sites.

DATE: April 13, 2006

Andrew please find below the outlay of the recent rehabilitation that was completed on the 14th of March and the 13th of April 2006.

STERLING VALLEY DRILL RIG SITES 001/002/003.

- All drill rig pads at Sterling Valley rehabilitated by Raymond Harback.
- All of the Sterling Valley drill pads had tags attached to PVC collars stating Exploration Company/Hole number and EL.
- **Sterling Valley 001**, the extensive supply of peat was placed back over the area disturbed and restored as close as possible to its original state.
- **Sterling Valley 002**, all top soil and peat was placed on the man made road with extensive organic matter being placed at strategic place to help native germination.
- **Sterling Valley 003**, all peat and gravels placed back onto the man made road, flowing water was directed into the Sterling Valley via the water trench already in place.
- **Total time** of machine movement **7 hours**.

FARRELL DRILL RIG SITES 004/006.

- Both drill rig pads were rehabilitated by Williams Earth Moving Contractors from Queenstown.
- All of the Farrell drill pads had tags attached to PVC collars stating Exploration Company/Hole number and EL.
- **Farrell Drill Rig Site 004/005**, rehabilitation was completed on the 13th of April 2006; the lack of peat was the determining factor on the amount of coverage over the drill rig pad and entrance.
- The entrance was blocked by the placement of a large tree stump.
- **Farrell 06/07/08** was sculptured to remove the undulating steepness thus to stop erosion.
- The extensive amount of peat on this site made for good coverage over disturbed area.
- **Total** movement time of machine **8 hours**.
