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Aboriginal Heritage Archaeological Survey EL40 2007 Balfour Joint Venture Proposal for R41S Prosect

Dear Jim,

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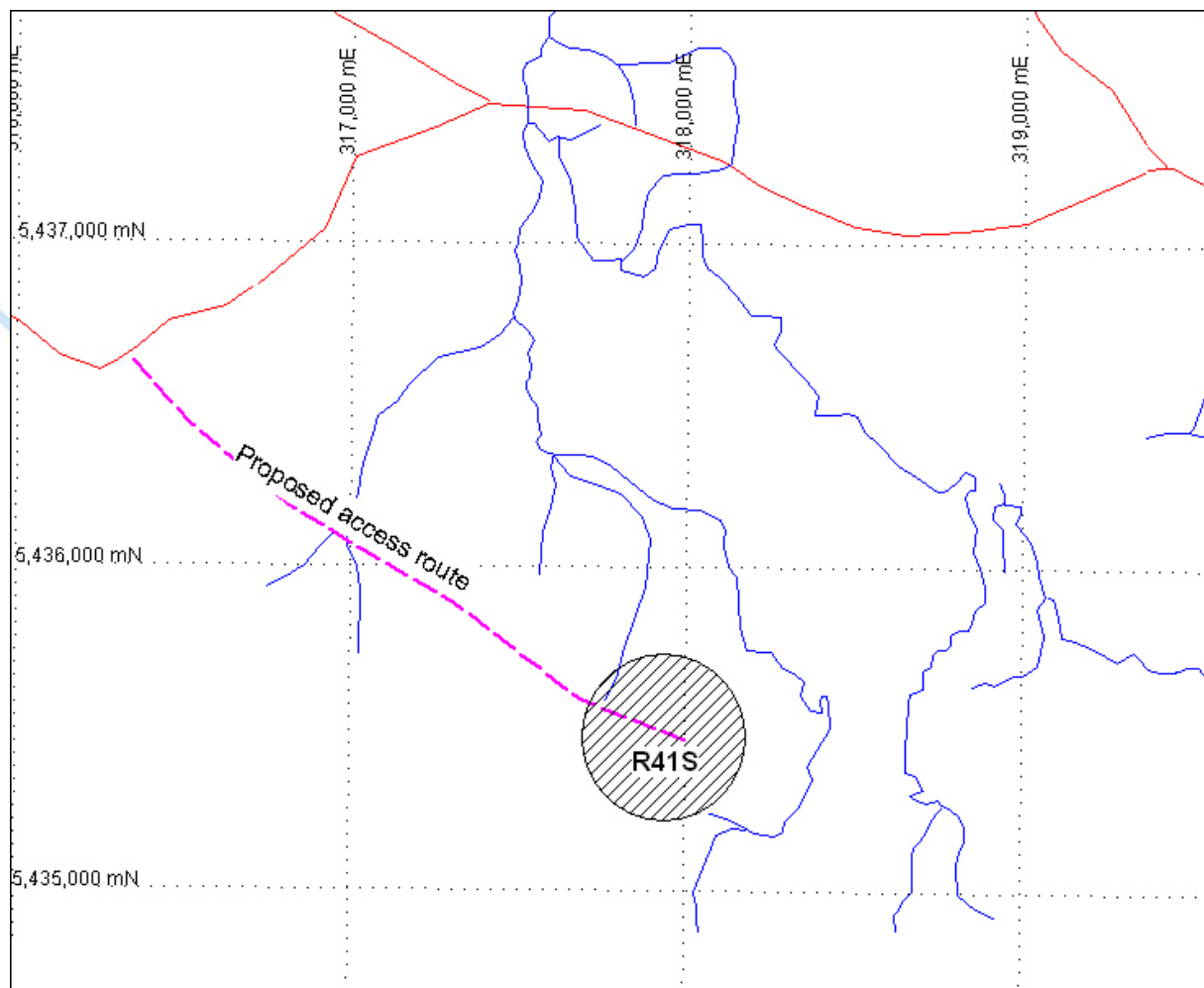


Figure 1. R41S drill site location. Coordinates are AMG66 Zone 55.

The Balfour Joint Venture (BJV) are exploring for Tin-Tungsten deposits within Precambrian sediments on the North West Coast of Tasmania. The BJV is an agreement between King Island Scheelite Ltd. (KIS) and Pleiades Resources Pty Ltd (PRPL) whereby KIS fund an exploration drilling program focussed on the Specimen Hill Sn mineralisation near Balfour. In addition to the Specimen Hill Program, the BJV plan to test a coincident gravity magnetic anomaly located in the NW of EL_2007 named R41S. The prospect is located on the Nelson River Plains, approximately 2km south of the Temma-Edith Creek Road (Figure 1).

The work program (drill hole and access) for the Nelson Bay River Plains area was forwarded to the MEWG last Wednesday (11th November). We received advice from Aboriginal Heritage Tasmania (AHT) late yesterday that an Aboriginal Heritage Investigation must be undertaken by a suitably qualified Consulting Archaeologist to ensure that the proposed works do not transgress the *Aboriginal Relics Act 1975*. AHT require the Archaeologist to contact them for advice on the scope of works required. AHT have supplied us with a list of Registered Archaeologists. They also supplied us with a link to their web site where there is a pdf of the *Standards and Guidelines Package for Consulting Archaeologists* (www.aboriginalheritage.tas.gov.au).

Access and Environmental Requirements

A Boart Longyear track mounted LF90 diamond drill rig is currently mobilised at Specimen Hill and is intended to be used for the short program.

The Prospect is located on open button grass plains approximately 2km south of the Heemskirk Road. The Rig will be walked over the button grass plain to the drill site. A total of six return trips over the plain are envisaged, three to mobilise the rig, drill sloop, fuel and equipment and three to demobilise.

There will be no earthworks associated with the program.

Can you please provide a quote for the proposed survey, liaison with Aboriginal Heritage Tasmania and reporting please.
