Further to our discussion last week, Great South Land Minerals Ltd formally request an extension of term of the Forest Practices Plan (North Lake Echo) currently in place and set to expire soon.

If possible, an extension of term for 5 years is requested to accommodate our current Bellevue drilling program, comprising two exploration wells.

The first of these holes is on private land, however, depending on the results of the first well, a second well may be placed over the area contained with the Forest Practices Plan.

GSLM currently had our exploration licence renewed (EL14/2009) on 17 May 2010 (GSLM's renewal application took 8 months to process by government). Previously, this was called SEL13/1998. Therefore some of the references may need to be changed within the plan relating to the licence number.

Thank you for being proactive in contacting the GSLM office regarding this issue. We are on limited resources at the moment.
