## BUSHFIRE SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

I am writing to provide you with consolidated advice for bushfire safety.

1. Great Southland Minerals Ltd drilling activities are required to equip themselves as if the operation were a forest products landing with the equipment required by Regulation 8 of the *Fire Service (Miscellaneous) Regulations 2007*.
2. Providing that Great Southland Minerals Ltd drilling sites are equipped as required in 1., gas flaring and drilling activities may occur on Days of Total Fire Ban.
3. Prior to commencement of gas flaring activities, the operators are to contact the Tasmania Fire Service on 1800 000 699 to notify the location and extent of the gas flaring.
4. The requirements in 1, above do not permit the lighting of fires.
5. These requirements will continue until 30 June 2012.
