

MINING NEWS.

GOLD.

The manager of the New Chum Company and several directors of that Company and the West New Chum Company went to Lefroy on Tuesday to be present at the cleaning up from crushings of both those companies. A telegram received last evening stated that from the New Chum Company, 610 tons stone were crushed, and 1858 oz amalgam were obtained (1265oz from plates and ripples and 593oz from boxes), which yielded 725oz retorted gold, value £2900, giving an average yield of 1oz 3dwt 22grs per ton. From the West New Chum Company's mine 893 tons stone were crushed, and 2530oz amalgam were obtained (1167oz from plates and ripples, and 1363oz from the boxes). The amalgam had not been retorted when the Telegraph-office closed last evening, but is expected to yield about 1000oz gold. The gold from both crushings will be brought up to town to-day.
