United Chum Extended.—Nov. 25 — After slabbing surface, logging up and fixing windlass on Saturday last, I started on Monday with three shifts to sink the main shaft, and so far am making good progress. Have sunk for five days 16ft, and slabbed same, making total depth to date from the surface 27ft. We have very fair working ground as yet, and if it continues the same shall make good headway.

West New Chum.—Nov. 26 —I have crushed 328 tons of quartz and obtained 467oz amalgam from plates and ripples.

New Chum.—A crushing of 188 tons has resulted in a return of 225oz of amalgam from plates and ripples.
