GOLD.

A general meeting of shareholders in the Deep Lead Co. is announced to take place at the Mechanics' Institute on Monday, the 14th inst., at 7 p.m.

LEFROY.

West New Chum.—Nov. 5—During the week 100 tons of stone have been crushed at the battery, the yield being 145oz of amalgam.

SALISBURY.

Victoria.—Nov. 4—The cross-cut at the lower level has been extended 4ft since my last report; still a deal of quartz in it, but nothing defined. I am still prospecting at the intermediate level, and have started to rise on some quartz leaders that are carrying a little gold. The battery is employed crushing the alluvial.

GLADSTONE.

Deskford.—Nov. 2—I have driven the drive in a north-east direction up close to the boundary. The drive has been extended for the week 11ft. I have crossed a strong leader of quartz 8in wide, highly charged with iron pyrites. The country has been a good deal mixed up with quartz all the the distance driven in this drive. I have tried specimens of quartz driven through, and can always get a good sample of pyrites, but cannot see any gold. The ground is a little harder for driving, but still favourable for the reef.
