

MINING INTELLIGENCE.

Messrs Hartnoll and Ferguson's scrip sale will take place at their mart at noon to-day.

Mr T. C. Just's next scrip sale will take place on Friday at noon.

Several of the directors of the New Chum and West Chum Companies proceeded to Lefroy to be present at the cleansing up yesterday from crushings of the companies named, the former at the New Native Youth Co.'s battery, and the West Chum at its own battery. A telegram received at Mr R. H. Price's office last evening stated that at the New Chum Co.'s crushing 1570oz amalgam were obtained from plates and ripples, and 596oz from the boxes, making a total of 2166oz., the quantity of stone crushed being 428 tons. The amalgam should yield over 800oz of gold. Mr Alex. Corrie received a telegram last evening stating that at the West Chum Co.'s battery 1643 tons of stone had been crushed, and 1764oz amalgam obtained from plates and ripples, and 483oz from the boxes, making a total of 2247oz of amalgam. This should yield over 800oz retorted gold.

A call of sixpence per share has been made in the Royal Mint Company, payable on Monday, 2nd May next. The manager also notifies that if the call of sixpence per share due on the 21st ult. is not paid before May 6th the shares will be liable to forfeiture.
